


**DECISION UNDER DELEGATED AUTHORITY ON AN APPLICATION
BY SKYCITY AUCKLAND LIMITED FOR APPROVAL TO INSTALL
A FIRE DOOR IN THE NEW POKER ZONE AT THE AUCKLAND CASINO**

Date of Decision:

30th June 2011

1. On 28 June 2011, SKYCITY Auckland Limited ("**SCAL**") applied, pursuant to conditions 6 and 7 of SCAL's venue licence, for approval to install fire doors in the new Poker Zone on level 3 of the Auckland casino. (SKYCITY is removing the gaming tables currently in the International Room on level 3 and replacing them with nine Poker tables. This area will become the new Poker Zone).
2. The nine Poker tables will occasionally attract a level of patronage that necessitates the installation of fire egress doors. Fire doors were not needed when the area operated as the International Room due to the low level of patronage.
3. The installation of the fire doors has no impact on the matters set out in condition 7 of SCAL's venue licence, and raises no other issues the Commission needs to consider. Accordingly the application is approved by the Executive Director under delegated authority pursuant to condition 7 of SCAL's venue licence.
4. The fire doors are to be constructed in accordance with the application.
