

**DECISION UNDER DELEGATED AUTHORITY ON AN APPLICATION
BY CHRISTCHURCH CASINOS LIMITED FOR APPROVAL OF
A NEW FLOOR PLAN FOR LEVEL 3 OF THE CHRISTCHURCH CASINO**

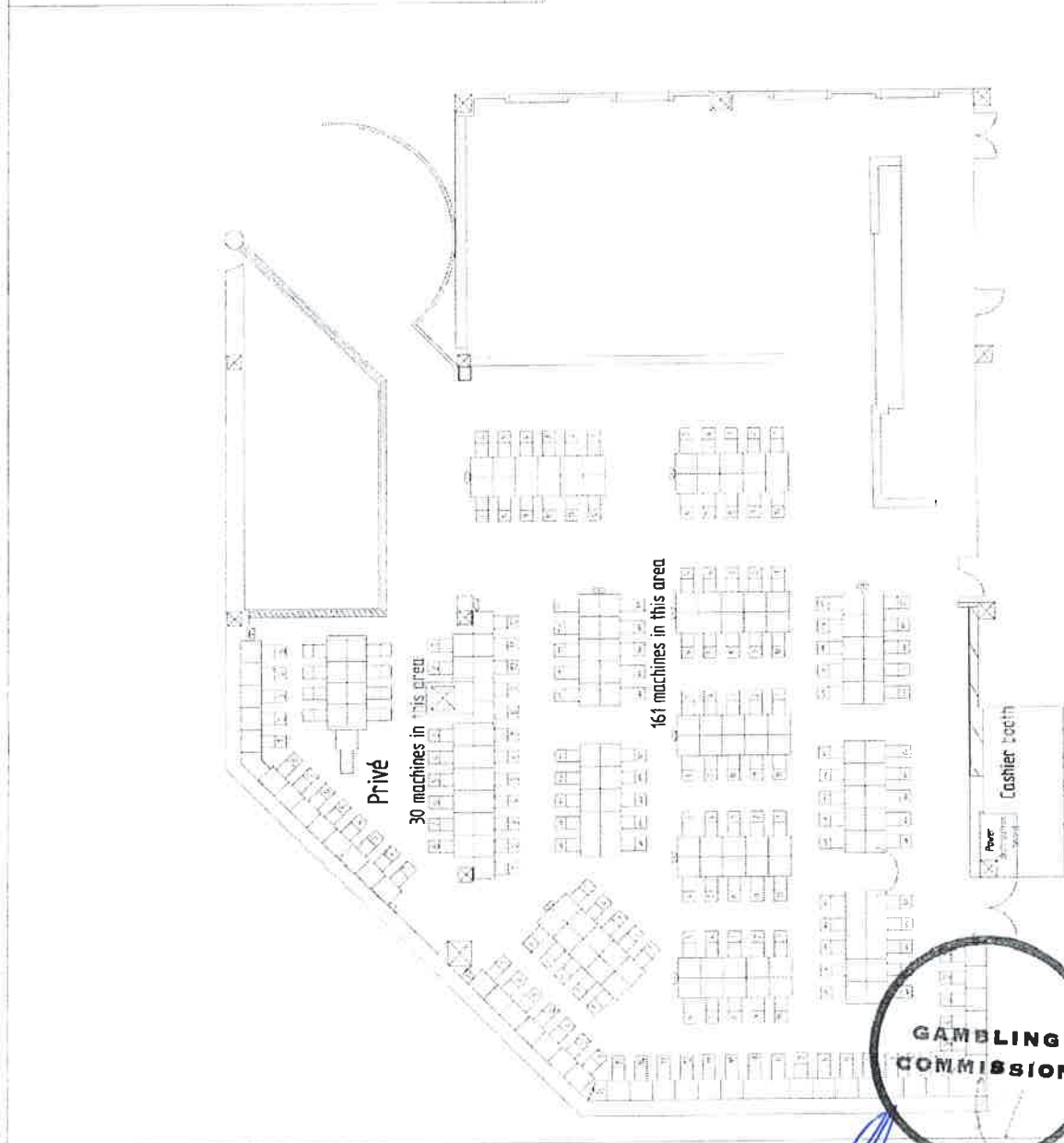
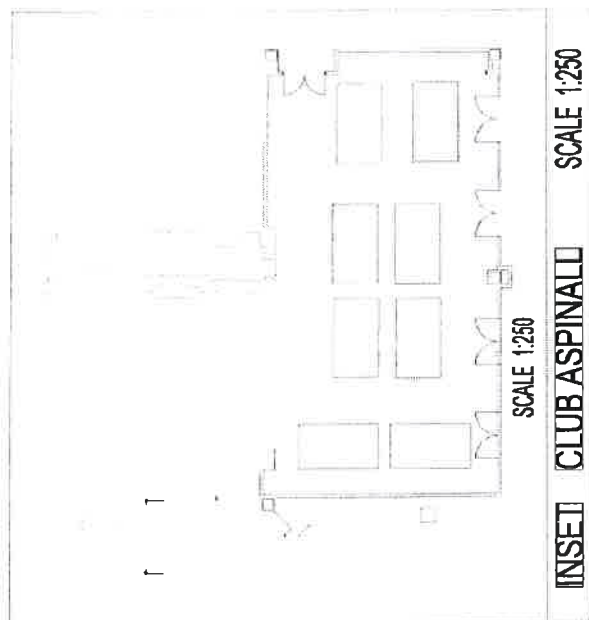
1. On 22 September 2011, Christchurch Casinos Limited ("CCL") applied, pursuant to condition 12 of its operator's licence for the Christchurch casino, for approval of floor plan "September 2011".
2. CCL has approval for up to 20 Rapid Roulette terminals, although it currently deploys only 14 terminals. The new floor plan involves the installation of two additional terminals which will be placed alongside the existing 14 terminals. The other casino tables will be moved to allow sufficient room. Public access ways will be unaffected.
3. The application raises no issues the Commission needs to consider. Accordingly floor plan "September 2011" is approved by the Chief Gambling Commissioner and the Executive Director under delegated authority pursuant to condition 12 of CCL's operator's licence. Plan "September 2011" is **attached**.
4. Once CCL is fully reliant on plan "September 2011", all previously approved floor plans will cease to be valid.
