


**DECISION UNDER DELEGATED AUTHORITY ON AN APPLICATION  
BY SKYCITY CASINO MANAGEMENT LIMITED FOR APPROVAL OF  
A NEW FLOOR PLAN FOR THE QUEENSTOWN CASINO**

**Date of Decision:** 12<sup>th</sup> October 2011

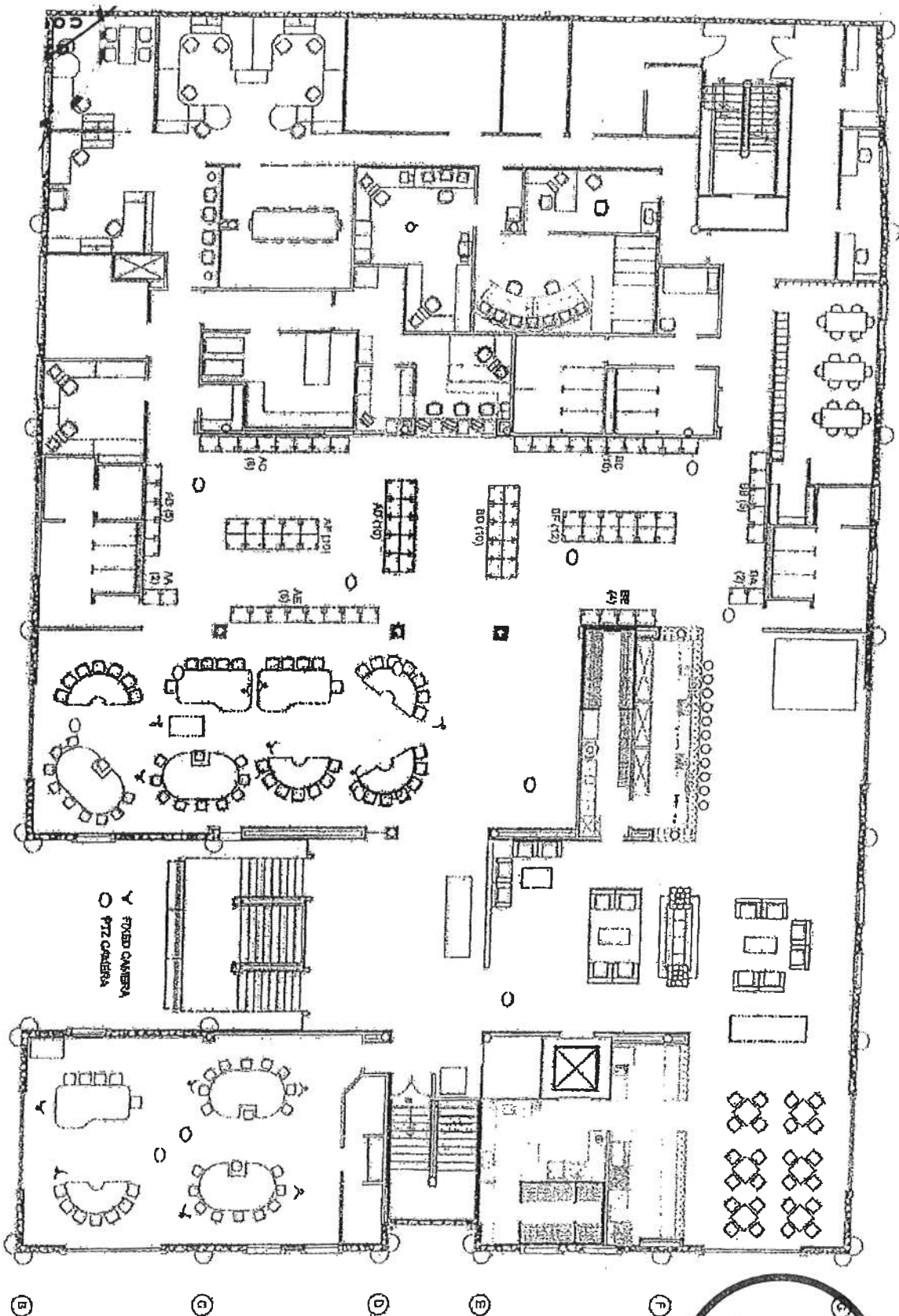
1. On 11 October 2011, SKYCITY Casino Management Limited ("SCML") applied, pursuant to condition 12 of its operator's licence for the Queenstown casino, for approval of floor plan "Second alternative gambling area floor layout 2011".
2. SCML currently has two floor plans approved for the Queenstown casino – "Standard gambling area floor layout 2009" and "Alternative gambling area floor layout 2009 Version 2". It wants to retain these plans and introduce a second alternative plan which provides for the operation of nine tables on the main gaming floor and three tables in the Summit Room.
3. SCML submitted that it would notify the DIA Inspectorate when it adopts the new plan and that any necessary adjustments to the CCTV coverage are undertaken to ensure compliance with the Surveillance Standard.
4. The application raises no issues the Commission needs to consider. Accordingly floor plan "Second alternative gambling area floor layout 2011" is approved by the Chief Gambling Commissioner and the Executive Director under delegated authority pursuant to condition 12 of SCML's operator's licence. Plan "Second alternative gambling area floor layout 2011" is **attached**, together with "Standard gambling area floor layout 2009" and "Alternative gambling area floor layout 2009 Version 2".
