

APPLICATION TO THE GAMBLING COMMISSION BY CHRISTCHURCH CASINOS LIMITED FOR RENEWAL OF ITS CASINO VENUE LICENCE

Pursuant to section 134 of the Gambling Act 2003 (the “**Act**”), Christchurch Casinos Limited (“**CCL**”) has applied to renew its casino venue licence for the casino located at 30-38 Victoria Street, Christchurch.

The application has been made to the Gambling Commission, which comprises five Commissioners as follows: Graeme Reeves (Chief Gambling Commissioner), Lisa Hansen, Russell Bell, Wendie Harvey and Donna Matahaere-Atariki.

A copy of CCL’s application, together with other relevant documents, will be made available on this website. Information will be uploaded, where relevant, on an ongoing basis.

The application was accompanied by completed personal information forms. Having regard to the detailed, private and commercially sensitive nature of much of the information recorded, the Commission is not presently making those documents publicly available, pursuant to section 135(1)(f) of the Act.

Pursuant to section 135(1)(g) of the Act, the Commission must conduct a public hearing of the application. Arrangements for the hearing will be publicly notified at a later date and also shown on this website.
