

**DECISION UNDER DELEGATED AUTHORITY ON AN APPLICATION
BY SKYCITY CASINO MANAGEMENT LIMITED FOR APPROVAL
OF A NEW FLOOR PLAN FOR THE HAMILTON CASINO**

Date of Decision: 25 June 2020


1. On 24 June 2020 SKYCITY Casino Management Limited ("SCML") applied, pursuant to conditions 11 and 12 of its operator's licence for the Hamilton casino, for approval of a temporary floor plan, "2020 HAM 003" for the Hamilton casino.
2. Conditions 11 and 12 of SCML's operator's licence for the Hamilton casino provide as follows:
 11. The Licence Holder shall operate in accordance with approved floor layouts showing the position of gaming tables and gaming machines.
 12. The Licence Holder shall obtain the approval of the Commission for new floor plans prior to relocating or installing tables or machines in positions not specified in approved floor layouts. When applying, the Licence Holder must submit fresh plans showing the floor layout for the Gambling Area and details of the proposed CCTV layout for the consideration of the Commission. Any changes must comply with the Surveillance Standard. The Executive Director and a single Gambling Commissioner may approve the new floor plans if they are satisfied that the floor layout has no potentially adverse effects. If they are not so satisfied, the proposed floor plan must be referred to the Commission for a decision on approval.
3. SCML submitted as follows:
 - (a) The Commission last year approved, under delegated approval, some construction and design changes at the Hamilton casino. At the same time it approved a floor plan to be implemented following completion of the changes.
 - (b) The plan was amended in January 2020 and again in June 2020 (plan "2020 HAM 002"). It is currently carrying out the previously approved construction and design changes and is transitioning to plan "2020 HAM 002".
 - (c) It now wants to make some further adjustments to the final placement of gaming product, following the design and structural changes on the MGF, as follows:
 - Install 6 EGMs
 - Remove 6 ATG terminals
 - (d) At all times, the number of EGMs and gaming tables will comply with the requirements of its licence conditions.

Decision

6. The floor plan proposal raises no issues of regulatory concern for the Commission. Accordingly, plan "2020 HAM 003" (**attached**) is approved by the Chief Gambling Commissioner and the Executive Director under delegated authority, pursuant to conditions 11 and 12 of SCML's operator's licence, for the Hamilton casino.
7. Once SCML is reliant on plan "2020 HAM 003", plan "2020 HAM 002" will cease to be valid.
