

**DECISION UNDER DELEGATED AUTHORITY ON AN
APPLICATION BY SKYCITY CASINO MANAGEMENT LIMITED FOR APPROVAL OF NEW
FLOOR PLANS FOR THE AUCKLAND CASINO**

Date of Decision: 14 April 2022

1. On 7 April 2022, SKYCITY Casino Management Limited (“SCML”) applied, pursuant to condition 11 of its operator’s licence for the Auckland casino, for approval of new floor plans, “2022 L2 001”, “2022 L3 001” and “2022 L5 001”.
2. Condition 11 of SCML’s operator’s licence for the Auckland casino provides as follows:
 11. The Licence Holder shall operate in accordance with approved floor layouts showing the position of gaming tables and gaming machines. The Licence Holder shall obtain approval for new floor plans prior to relocating or installing tables or machines in positions not specified in approved floor layouts. When applying, the Licence Holder must submit fresh plans showing the floor layout for the Gambling Area and details of the proposed CCTV layout for consideration. Any change must comply with the Surveillance Standard. The Executive Director and a single Gambling Commissioner may approve the new floor plans if they are satisfied that the floor layout has no potentially adverse effects. If they are not so satisfied, the proposed floor plan must be referred to the Commission for a decision on approval.

Submissions

3. SCML submitted as follows:
 - (a) In anticipation of Auckland moving from ‘red’ to ‘orange’ in the traffic light system under the COVID Protection Framework (CPF) it seeks approval of 3 new floor plans.
 - (b) Should the new plans be approved, they will be deployed when Auckland moves to ‘orange’ under the CPF.
 - (c) The proposed new floor plans include the following changes:

Level 2 – 2022 L2 001

- Remove bank of 6 x ATG terminals
- Install 4 x ATG terminals to create 2 banks of 5
- Remove 2 x ATG terminals
- Remove 2 x ATG terminals
- Remove 1 ATG terminal from 2 banks

Level 3 – 2022 L3 001

- Reconfigure alignment of 2 x tables in the Baccarat Room
- Install 2 x gaming machines

Level 5 - 2022 L5 001

- Install 2 x 1 ATG terminal
- Remove 3 x ATG terminals and reposition terminals
- Remove 2 x tables and reposition remaining tables


- (d) Changes to the CCTV layout will be implemented to ensure ongoing compliance with the Surveillance Standard.

Decision

4. The Commission was satisfied that the proposed floor plans raised no issues of regulatory concern. Accordingly, plans "2022 L2 001", "2022 L3 001" and "2022 L5 001" (**attached**) are approved by the Chief Gambling Commissioner and the Executive Director under delegated authority, pursuant to condition 11 of SCML's operator's licence for the Auckland casino. Once SCML is reliant upon plan 2022 L2 001, plan 2021 L2 005 will cease to be valid. Once SCML is reliant upon plan 2022 L3 001, plan 2021 L3 001 will cease to be valid. Once SCML is reliant upon plan 2022 L5 001, plan 2020 L5 001 will cease to be valid.

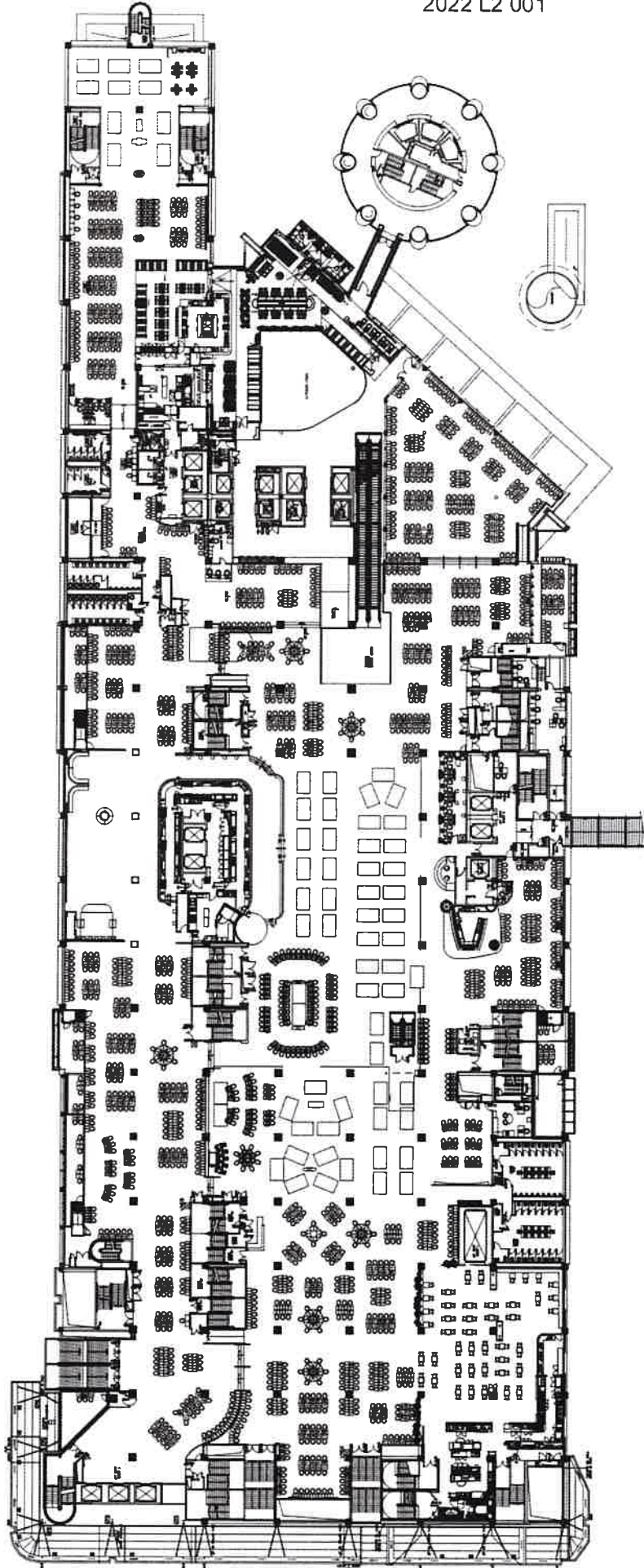

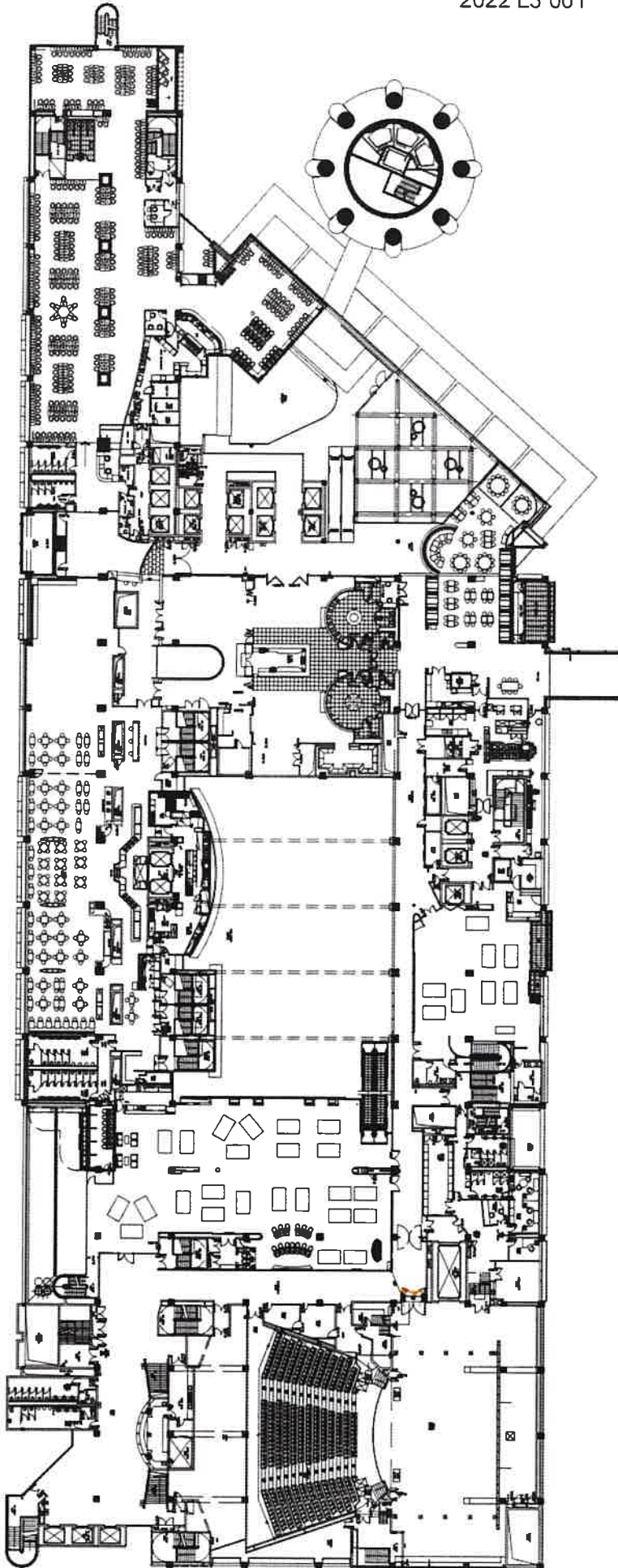
