

**DECISION UNDER DELEGATED AUTHORITY ON AN APPLICATION
BY DUNEDIN CASINOS MANAGEMENT LIMITED FOR APPROVAL OF
A NEW FLOOR PLAN FOR THE DUNEDIN CASINO**

Date of Decision: 7 July 2022


1. On 1 July 2022, Dunedin Casinos Management Limited (“**DCML**”) applied, pursuant to condition 12 of its operator’s licence for the Dunedin Casino, for approval of an additional new floor plan, “Grand Casino Gaming Floor Plan June 2022”.
2. Conditions 11 and 12 provide as follows:
 11. The Licence Holder shall operate in accordance with approved floor layouts showing the position of gaming tables and gaming machines.
 12. The Licence Holder shall obtain approval for new floor plans prior to relocating or installing tables or machines in positions not specified in approved floor layouts. When applying, the Licence Holder must submit fresh plans showing the floor layout for the Gambling Area and details of the proposed CCTV layout for consideration. Any change must comply with the Surveillance Standard. The Executive Director and a single Gambling Commissioner may approve the new floor plans if they are satisfied that the floor layout has no potentially adverse effects. If they are not so satisfied, the proposed floor plan must be referred to the Commission for a decision on approval.
3. DCML submitted as follows:
 - (a) It seeks approval of an additional new floor plan to coincide with the rugby test taking place in Dunedin on the weekend.
 - (b) It wants to relocate two gaming tables from the Gainsborough Room to the old smokers’ room. Due to staffing constraints it is unlikely these gaming tables will be opened. However if they are, a supervisory staff member will be present because there is currently insufficient camera coverage.
 - (c) The purpose of the relocation is to create more room in the Gainsborough Room to accommodate a large LED TV screen on the curtains on the far wall so that patrons can view the rugby. The TV unit includes a stand on which the TV is mounted. No fixings will be utilised to install the TV. It will require only a power supply and an HDMI cable from a nearby location which is currently used for a smaller TV.
 - (d) It also wants to install two temporary portable bars. Each bar will consist of a rented trestle table, a small commercial refrigeration unit and an EFTPOS machine for debit card charge only. No cash will be available. Ice will be kept in a chilly-bin. There will be no beer taps or other plumbing of any kind and nothing will be attached

to walls or floors. In addition, one wheeled storage unit may be utilised to store bottled beer, glassware, etc.

- (e) It currently has three floor plans; "Grand Casino Main Gaming Floor Plan December 2021", "Grand Casino COVID Protection Framework – Red Floor Plan No Zones December 2021" and "Grand Casino COVID Protection Framework – Red Floor Plan 2 Zones December 2021". It currently operates under plan "Grand Casino Main Gaming Floor Plan December 2021". It intends to retain Plans "Grand Casino COVID Protection Framework – Red Floor Plan No Zones December 2021" and "Grand Casino COVID Protection Framework – Red Floor Plan 2 Zones December 2021" in place in case it needs to revisit them.
- (f) If approved, it wants to immediately implement plan "Grand Casino Gaming Floor Plan June 2022".
4. The proposal raises no issues of regulatory concern for the Commission. Accordingly, plan "Grand Casino Gaming Floor Plan June 2022" (**attached**) is approved by the Chief Gambling Commissioner and the Executive Director under delegated authority pursuant to conditions 11 and 12 of DCML's operator's licence for the Dunedin Casino.



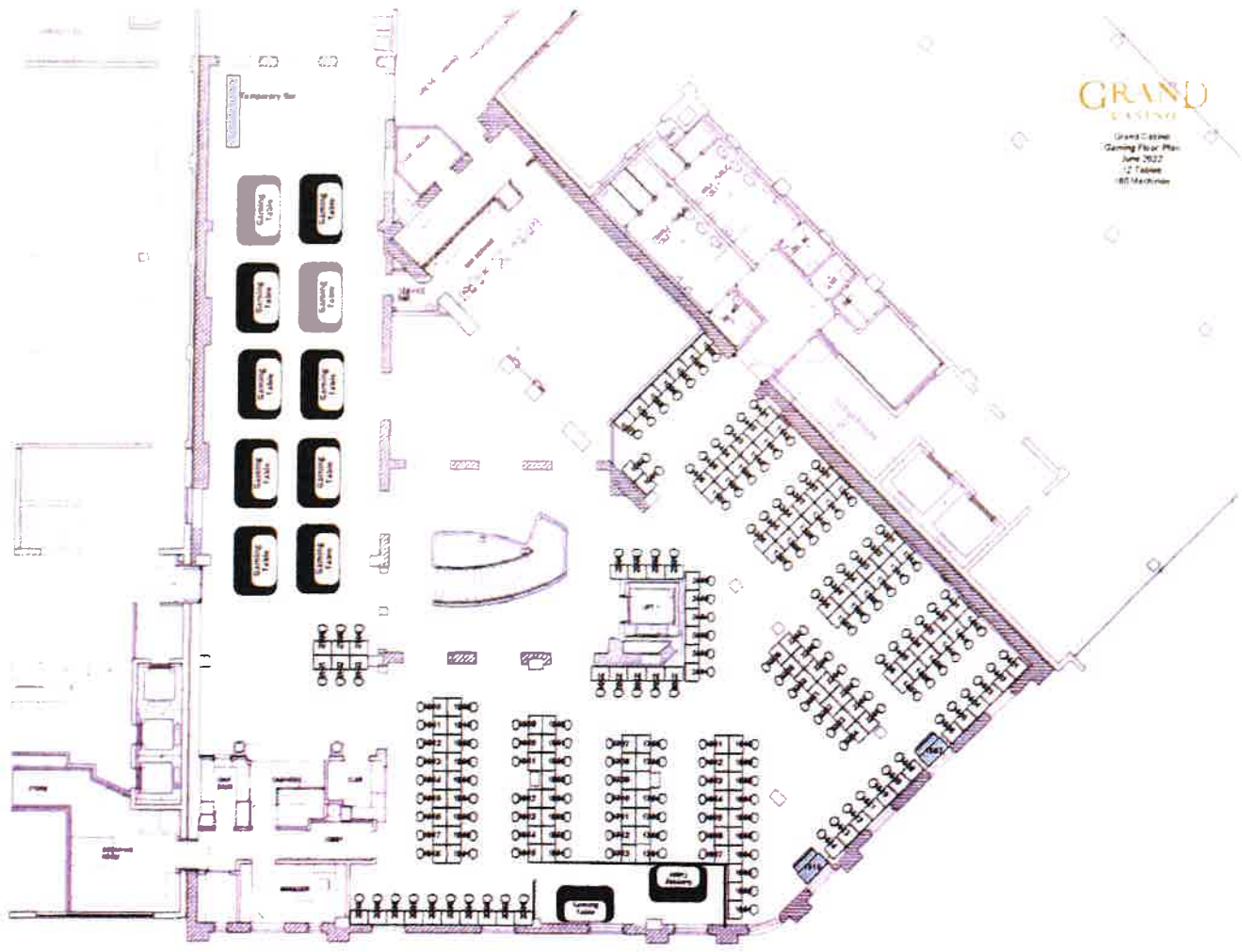
