

**DECISION UNDER DELEGATED AUTHORITY ON AN APPLICATION
BY CHRISTCHURCH CASINOS LIMITED FOR APPROVAL OF
NEW FLOOR PLANS FOR LEVELS 1 AND 2 OF THE CHRISTCHURCH CASINO**

Date of Decision: 19 January 2018

1. On 29 December 2017, Christchurch Casinos Limited ("CCL") applied, pursuant to condition 12 of its operator's licence, for approval of floor plans "Level 1 – Floor plan Option A – January 2018", optional floor plan, "Level 1 – Floor plan Option B – January 2018" and "Level 2 – January 2018" for levels 1 and 2 at the Christchurch casino.
2. Condition 12 provides as follows:

The Licence Holder shall obtain the approval of the Commission for new floor plans prior to relocating or installing tables or machines in positions not specified in approved floor layouts. When applying the Licence Holder must submit fresh plans showing the floor layout for the Gambling Area and details of the proposed CCTV layout for the consideration of the Commission. Any change must comply with the Surveillance Standard. The Executive Director and a single Gambling Commissioner may approve the new floor plans if they are satisfied that the floor layout has no potentially adverse effects. If they are not so satisfied, the proposed floor plan must be referred to the Commission for a decision on approval.

3. CCL submitted that:
 - (a) It wants to relocate 10 electronic gaming machines ("EGMs") on its Main Gaming Floor (level 1) as follows:
 - relocate six EGMs from the island bank close to the Valley Bar to in front of the EGMs on the cash desk wall on level 1 (near the tables area);
 - relocate four EGMs (two currently against the wall, and two from the end of the remaining island bank to the left of the Valley Bar on level 1) to the VIP room, Aspinalls, on level 2.
 - (b) This would create more space for players in the corners of the wall bank and more room for egress between the island bank and the Valley Bar on level 1. This area can currently become quite congested.
 - (c) Relocating four EGMs to level 2 will address the increased demand for EGMs within the VIP room.
4. The proposal raises no issues of regulatory concern for the Commission. Accordingly plans "Level 1 – Floor plan Option A – January 2018", "Level 1 – Floor plan Option B – January 2018" and "Level 2 – January 2018" (attached) are approved by the Chief




Gambling Commissioner and the Executive Director under delegated authority pursuant to condition 12 of CCL's operator's licence for the Christchurch casino.

5. Once CCL is reliant on plan "Level 1 – Floor plan Option A – January 2018", plan "Level 1 – Floor plan Option A" will cease to be valid.
6. Once CCL is reliant on plan "Level 1 – Floor plan Option B – January 2018", plan "Level 1 – Floor plan Option B" will cease to be valid.
7. Once CCL is reliant on plan "Level 2 – January 2018", plan "2016 L2 001" will cease to be valid.

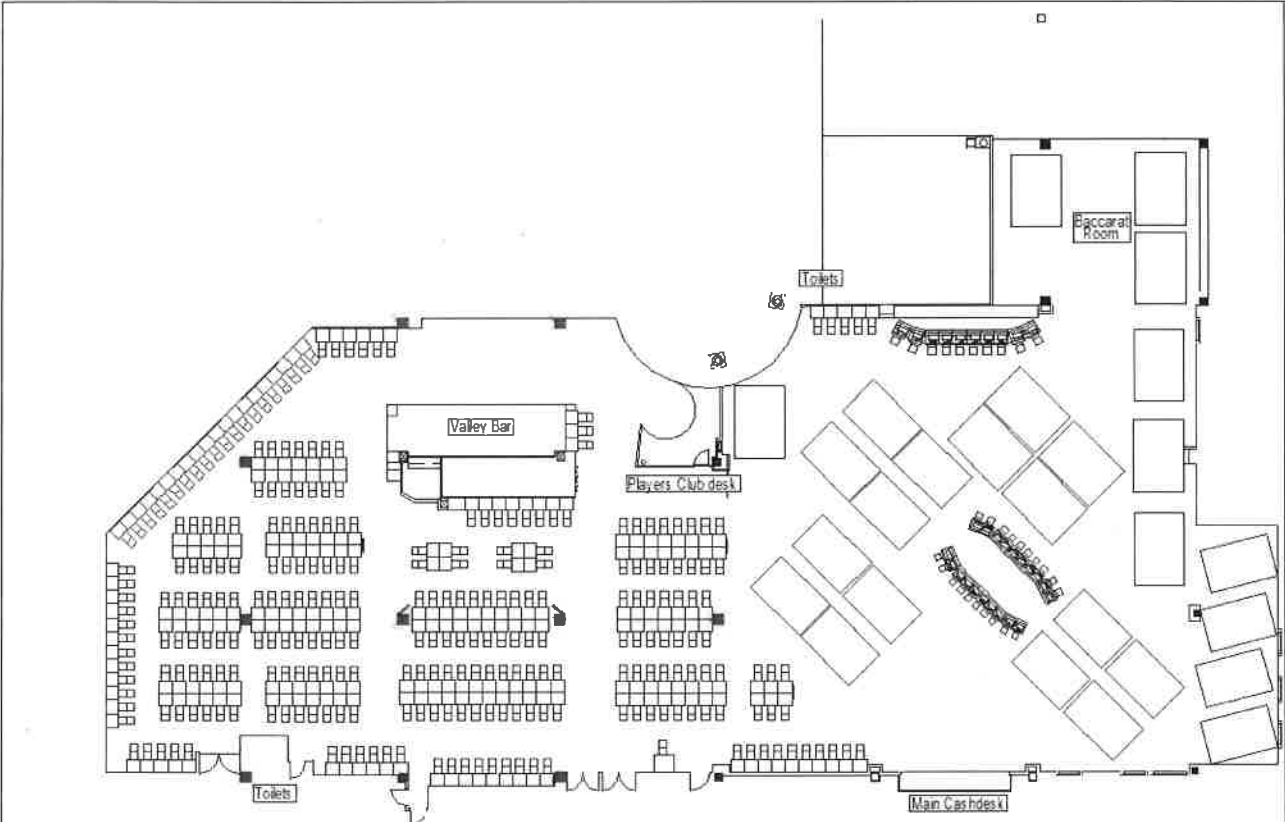

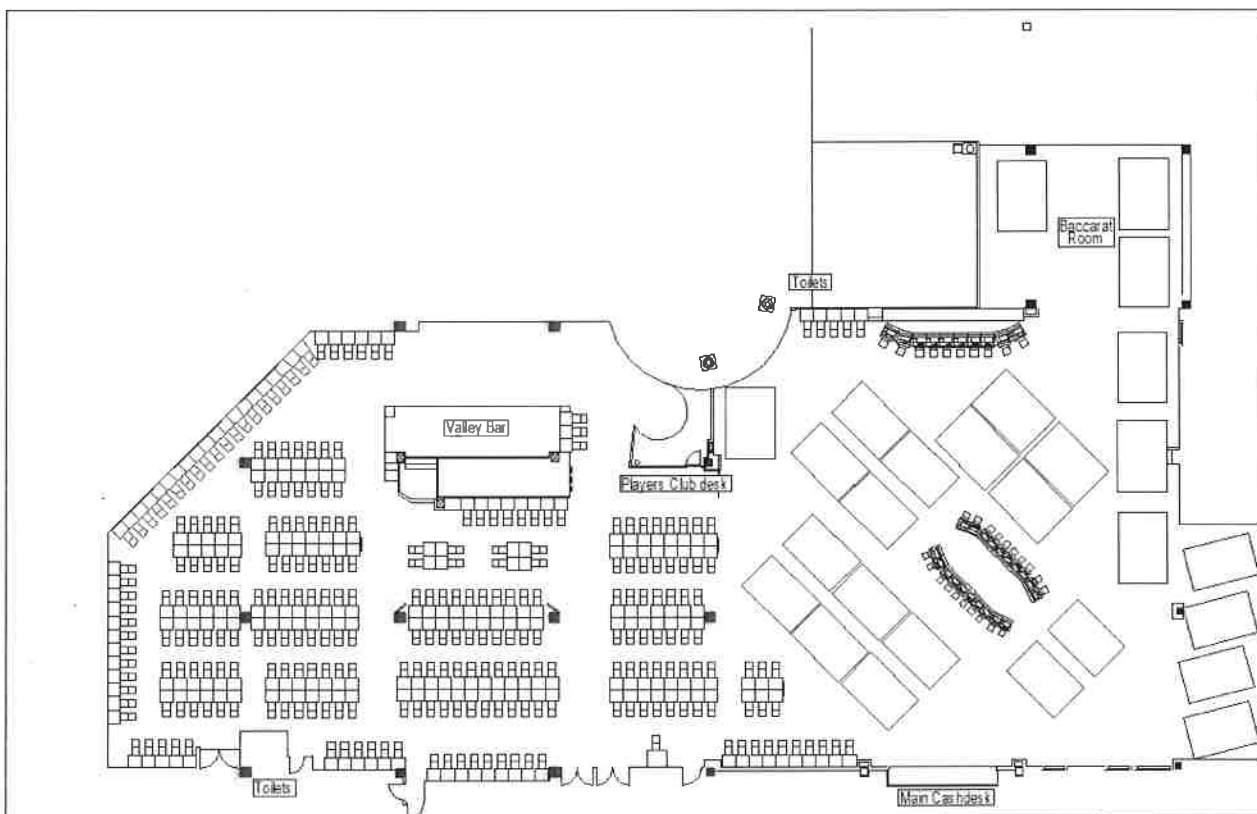
Level 1 – Floor plan Option A – January 2018
