

**DECISION UNDER DELEGATED AUTHORITY ON AN APPLICATION
BY DUNEDIN CASINOS MANAGEMENT LIMITED FOR APPROVAL OF
NEW FLOOR PLANS FOR THE DUNEDIN CASINO**

Date of Decision: 24 August 2018

1. On 1 August 2018, Dunedin Casinos Management Limited (“DCML”) applied, pursuant to conditions 11 and 12 of its operator’s licence for the Dunedin Casino, for approval of new floor plans, “Table Games Floor Plan JUL 18” and “Gaming Machines Floor Plan JUL 18”.
2. Conditions 11 and 12 provide as follows:
 11. The Licence Holder shall operate in accordance with approved floor layouts showing the position of gaming tables and gaming machines.
 12. The Licence Holder shall obtain approval for new floor plans prior to relocating or installing tables or machines in positions not specified in approved floor layouts. When applying, the Licence Holder must submit fresh plans showing the floor layout for the Gambling Area and details of the proposed CCTV layout for consideration. Any change must comply with the Surveillance Standard. The Executive Director and a single Gambling Commissioner may approve the new floor plans if they are satisfied that the floor layout has no potentially adverse effects. If they are not so satisfied, the proposed floor plan must be referred to the Commission for a decision on approval.
3. DCML submitted as follows:
 - (a) It wants to move a Tai Sai table to a new location in the gaming tables area and place six Vegas Star terminals in its place.
 - (b) The six Vegas Star terminals will replace six gaming machines which will be removed from the gaming machine area. Vegas Star is deemed to be a gaming machine.
 - (c) As a result of this change, it needs to reconfigure the current table layout.
 - (d) The area vacated by the six gaming machines will be available for patrons to take a break.
 - (e) The game mixes and gambling opportunities will be unaffected by this proposal.
 - (f) There is no need to adjust the CCTV layout to ensure ongoing compliance with the Surveillance Standard.
4. The proposal raises no issues of regulatory concern for the Commission. Accordingly plans “Table Games Floor Plan JUL 18” and “Gaming Machines Floor Plan JUL 18” are


approved by the Chief Gambling Commissioner and the Executive Director under delegated authority pursuant to conditions 11 and 12 of DCML's operator's licence for the Dunedin Casino.

- 5. Once DCML is reliant on "Table Games Floor Plan JUL 18", "TG Floor Plan OCT 15" will cease to be valid.
- 6. Once DCML is reliant on "Gaming Machines Floor Plan JUL 18", "Gaming Machines Floor Plan DEC 15" will cease to be valid.



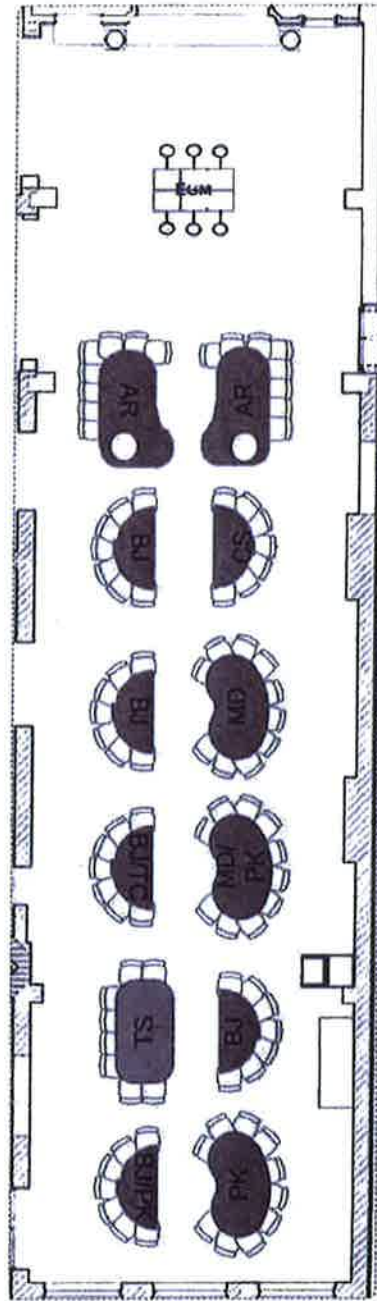

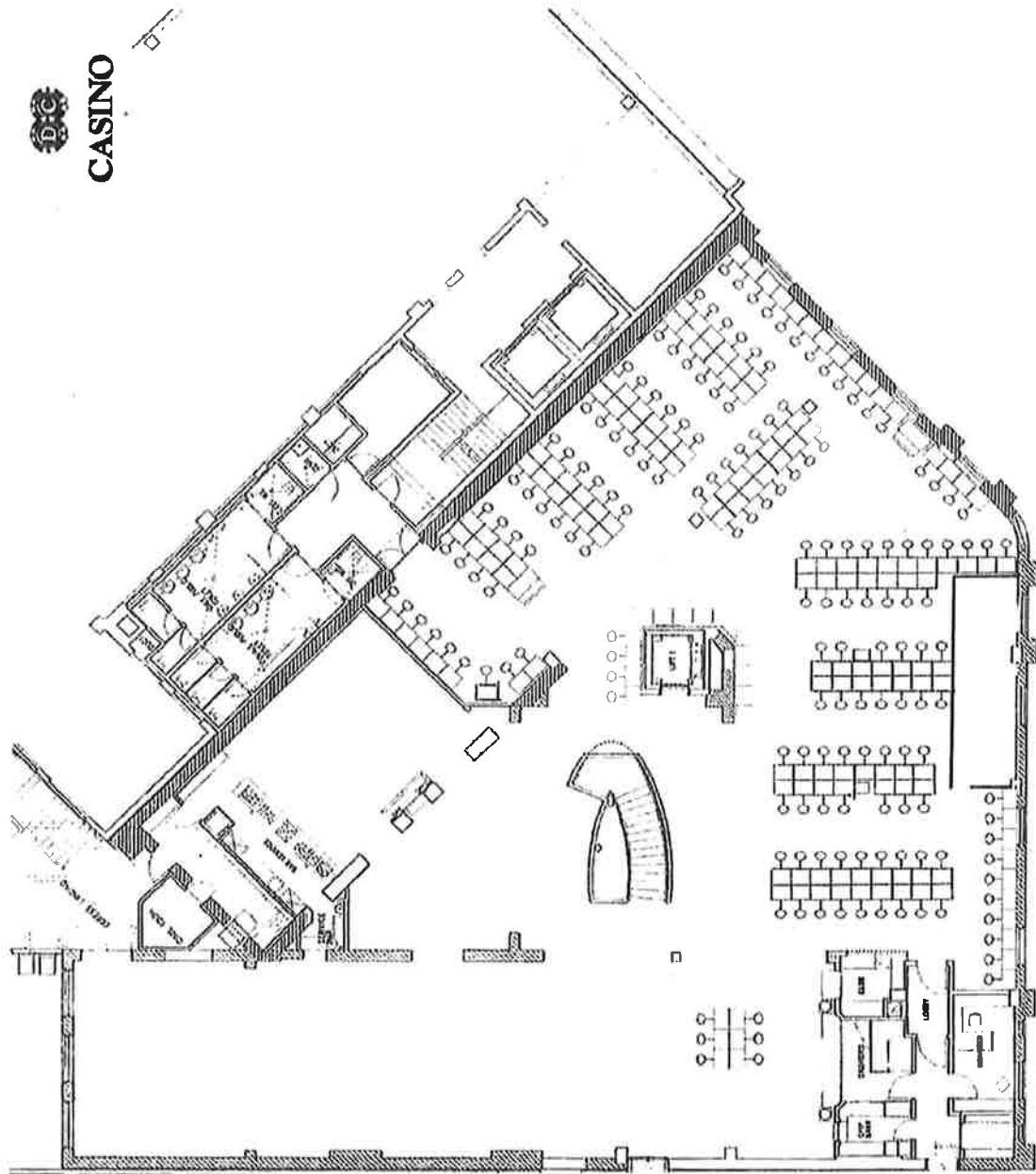
