

NOTICE OF HEARING OF APPLICATION BY DUNEDIN CASINOS LIMITED FOR RENEWAL OF ITS CASINO VENUE LICENCE

The Gambling Commission has received an application from Dunedin Casinos Limited to renew the casino venue licence for Grand Casino, located at the Southern Cross Hotel, 118 High Street, Dunedin. If granted, the application would permit the Casino to operate at this location for another 15 years.

The application is made under section 134 of the Gambling Act 2003 ("**Act**").

In May 2024, the Commission gave public notice of the application, invited written submissions on the application and invited people who wished to appear and be heard at a public hearing of the application, to apply to the Commission for authorisation.

This Notice provides details of the upcoming public hearing.

Hearing

Pursuant to section 135(1)(g) of the Act, the Commission must conduct a public hearing of the application, and pursuant to section 135(1)(e), the Commission must give public notice of the commencement of the hearing, and of how people may find out when and where the hearing is to be held.

The Commission hereby gives notice that the public hearing will take place in Conference Room 1 at the Dunedin Centre, 1 Harrop Street, Dunedin. The hearing will commence at 9am on 20 September 2024.
