

APPLICATION TO THE GAMBLING COMMISSION BY DUNEDIN CASINOS LIMITED FOR RENEWAL OF ITS CASINO VENUE LICENCE

Pursuant to section 134 of the Gambling Act 2003 (the “**Act**”), Dunedin Casinos Limited (“**DCL**”) has applied to renew its casino venue licence for the casino located at the Southern Cross Hotel, 118 High Street, Dunedin.

The application has been made to the Gambling Commission, which comprises five Commissioners as follows: Susan Hughes KC (Chief Gambling Commissioner), Scott Pearson, William (Bill) Acton, Sarah Shaw and Carolyn Risk.

A copy of DCL’s application, together with other relevant documents, will be made available on this website. Information will be uploaded, where relevant, on an ongoing basis.

The application was accompanied by completed personal information forms. Having regard to the detailed, private and commercially sensitive nature of much of the information recorded, the Commission is not presently making those documents publicly available, pursuant to an agreement as provided for in section 135(1)(f) of the Act.

Pursuant to section 135(1)(g) of the Act, the Commission must conduct a public hearing of the application. Arrangements for the hearing will be publicly notified at a later date and also shown on this website.
